MBB = Muslim Background Believer
 - They may be rejected by their family if it is found out they are a follower of Jesus.
 - They may lose their home and have to flee the area or country.
 - Their life may be in immediate danger of imprisonment or death.
2. Who are the Rohingya, where are they from, and where do they reside now?
They are a people group that has been pushed from their homeland in Myanmar and suffered unimaginable persecution and genocide and are now living in refugee camps in the southern part of Bangladesh.
3. What forces and situations drive a people from their homes and countries?
War, Famine, Genocide, Government Change of Power, Accepting Christ
4. How do we see God use crisis for good? In what ways are doors opened to share the gospel?
In times of crisis we as God's people are able to meet someone's needs physically. That can open the door to share why we are caring for the person. In time of vulnerability, people are asking the big questions such as 'Why is this happening to me?' or 'Why am I here?' We have the answers to those questions. People from displaced countries are often moved to areas where they can then be reached by believers ie.. Refugee camps.
