## Every Nation Update Kenya | Discussion Guide

### Ministry and Kenya:

1. When Greg said, the “low hanging fruit of missions is done” what did he mean? What is the difference between a country and a nation and how does that difference impact one’s approach to ministry?  
The word of God has spread to the easier to reach locations. We must look at the inconvenient, inadequate, undesirable locations - the places few are willing to go. There are often many nations within a country. Many languages, people groups, and tribes. When approaching ministry, you need to look at the individual people group.
2. Why are the National Leaders such an integral part of sharing the Word of God? What kinds of difficulties do they face in sharing the gospel?  
The National Leader understands the culture, language, and barriers within the society. When the message comes from someone who speaks their own language and dialect and looks like them, the person is focused on the message not on the differences. Leaders who are from their own country often have a passion for their people and want to stay in their country to see the gospel spread.
3. What was Mark’s vision and passion for raising up leaders?  
Leading those to Christ, discipling them in their walk with Jesus and helping them to share the gospel with their friends and family.
4. According to the video, what will cause the Gospel to go viral?  
Boreholes (wells) have transformed village life. Often the people are in such dire circumstances they need the compassion of food and water before they can even think of any spiritual needs. Water becomes the gateway for people to see the hands and feet of Jesus, which enables the gospel to spread.

### Discussion:
